We thank **Fred Miyahara** for taking the time to drive up from San Diego. Fred gave us a great demonstration on Black Pines. For most of us, working with a black pine is a love/hate relationship. Fortunately, Fred was able to give a nice presentation on basic care and maintenance for our black pines. He went over how to pluck old needles during the fall and also gave us a nice overview on the different varieties of black pines. On the trees that he brought in, he discussed a few of the flaws that he had on his black pines and went over how he was planning on correcting them. He also gave us his recipe for soil mix which could be helpful for many of us since black pines are often prone to root rot.

Overall, Fred's presentation was a great introduction to working with black pines. At the end, we all walked away with a nice quiz to test ourselves on black pines. Hopefully, everybody scored 50 out of 50 on it. If not, the quiz still serves as a great reference for when we're working on our black pines. --Jason Chan
